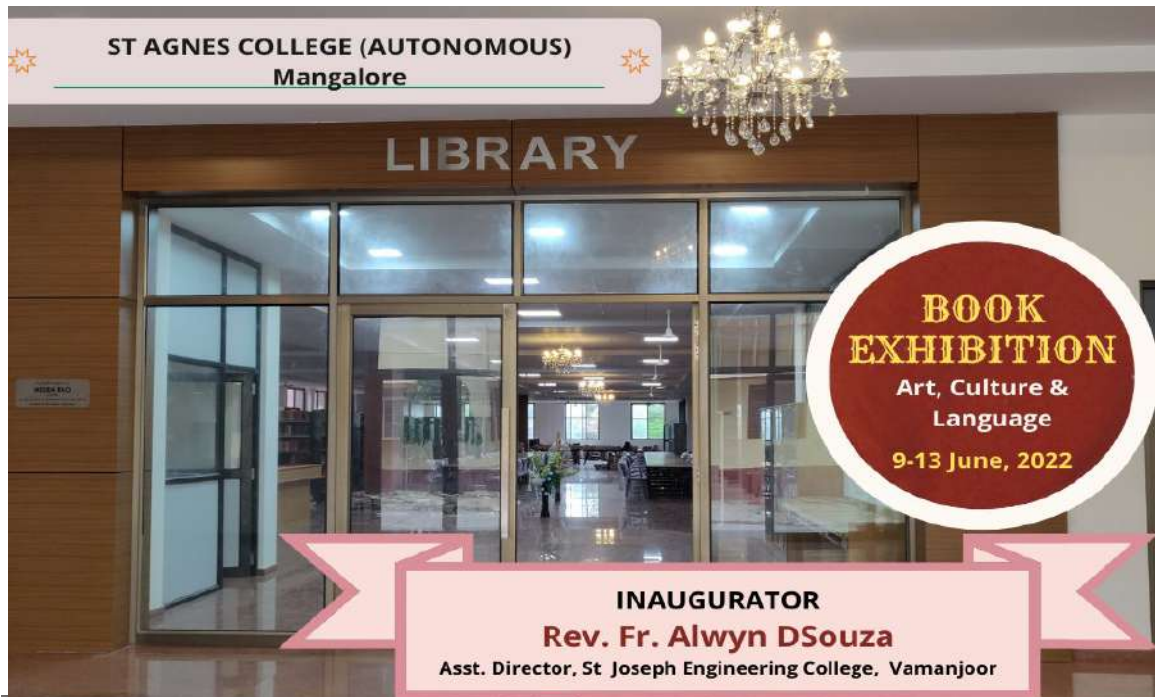

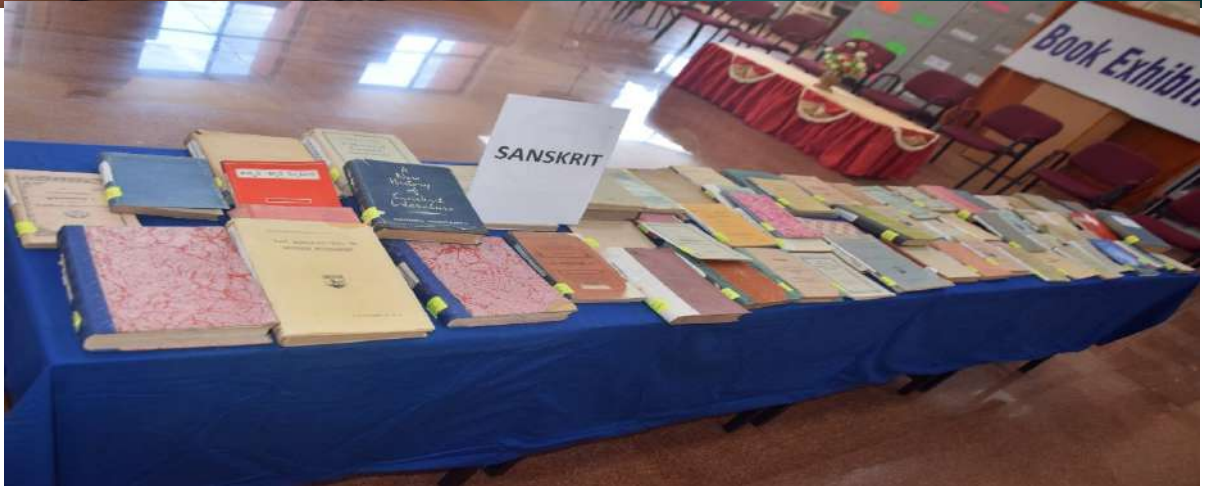

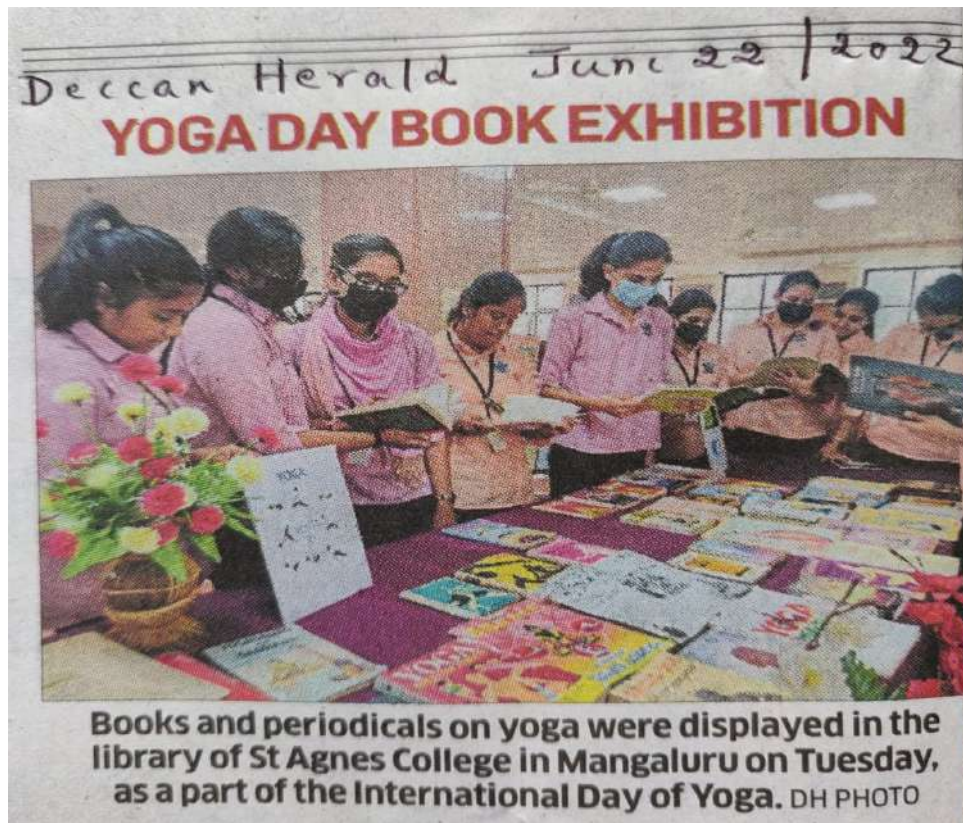
Report of the Art - Culture Based Book Exhibition

Reading improves thinking ability and analytical skills said Prof. Talwar, Former Vice Chancellor of Mysore University, who was the Chief Guest at the celebration. He praised the outstanding contributions of Dr S.R. Ranganathan to the development of libraries from an unorganized library to a more systematic process of arranging and preserving the treasure house of knowledge. 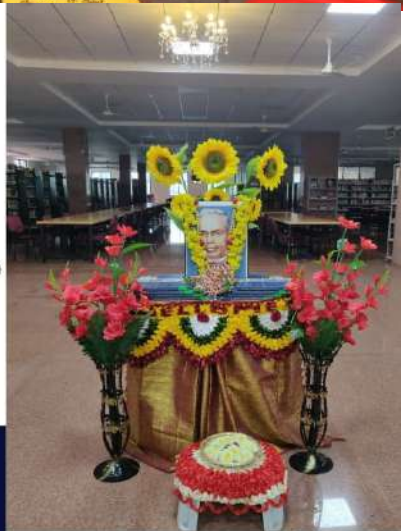

Rare book collection at St Agnes College digitised

St Agnes College in Mangaluru has set a new milestone towards ensuring tech-savvy facilities for its students, research scholars and staff.

The Library and Information Centre of the college has taken up a project 'Digitization of Rare Collection', funded by Conard N Hilton Foundation, USA.

The project is ambitious and complements the UGC and NAAC directions and the aspirations of NEP 2020 on upgrading technologies in educational institutions.

Rare collection
Some rare items in the college library are, 'Travels in South Europe' by William Bingley (1821), 'La Saint Esclavage: De L'admirable Mere De Dieu' by Lui Dieu (published by Macmillan India Ltd., Madras, 1836), St Dominic by Jean Guiraud (1913), 'The Holy Gospel' by P.Lethecleux (1910), 'Logic' (Science Primers) by Jevons W S (Macmillan & co.Ltd., London, 1876), 'History of Rome' by Livius T (1892), 'French Poetry for the Young' by Oger Victor (George G Harrap & Co. Ltd., London, 1896), 'Foundations of Modern Physics' by Brown Thomas B. (John Wiley, New York, 1940), 'New Geography of the Indian Empire' by Morrison Cameron (Thomas Nelson & Sons Ltd., London, 1906), 'Bhagavadgita' by Tatya Tukaram (1920), Kalidasa's 'Raghuvamsha', 'Abhijana Shakuntala', Bhasa's 'Swapna Vasavadatta', Gunavarma's 'Pushpadanta Purana', Sriharsha's 'Nagananda', Kumara Valmiki's 'Torave Ramayana', 'Mrichchhakatika' of Sudraka (1936), 'The Historical inscription of South India', 'A History of South India' by Nilakanta Shastri (1955), 'Srimad Valmikiramayanaam' (1939), Botanical Atlas, among others, have been digitized and preserved.

Library has taken the initiative to preserve and promote rare books on religion, literature, philosophy, biography and other subjects," she added.

University of Mysore former vice chancellor Prof V G Talavar, viewing the digitization work at the college, during a programme recently, said that the digitization of old books is the need of the hour.

The Central government has been stressing on the digitization of old books. The digitization will be of great help to the teachers and students as many old books are not reprinted, he said.

Century-old library
The college library has given equal importance to the rare collection as well as the latest reference collection.

In the past 100 years, the library moved from the traditional method to the modern method of operation.

Being a century-old library, the library of St Agnes College has a collection of 62,114 books.

Repository DSPACE and access will be provided within the campus with password protection.

RFID technology
The library also implemented Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) technology for its entire collection and St Agnes College Principal Sr Dr M Venissa said that the college is the first one among the colleges affiliated with Mangalore University to successfully implement the RFID Technology.

RFID will improve the security of library collections, she added.

St Agnes College selection grade librarian Dr Vishala B K said the oldest books from the large collection of the St Agnes College library are being scanned and digitized.

"Initially, 300 books were selected for restoration in the first phase and the work is in progress. St Agnes College
